### Updates

SilentPrint 1.12 has the following updates:

- Adobe PDF Printer Driver Support

### Adobe PDF Printer Driver Support

The Adobe PDF printer driver, which is supplied with Adobe Acrobat 6, is now supported. This enables any document supported by SilentPrint to be converted to PDF using this driver.

---

### Upgrade Facility

An Upgrade button has been added to the Registration dialog to enable SilentPrint users to upgrade to a different version without having to manually locate and delete the **li.dat** file.

---

### File Mask Feature

A file mask feature has been added to the Configuration dialog to provide further control over which documents are processed within a Watched folder.

---

The following wildcard characters can be used to determine which documents are processed:

- **Asterisk \*** Use the asterisk as a substitute for zero or more characters. If you want to process documents that start with **Gloss**, specify **Gloss\***. This processes all documents of any supported type that begin with **Gloss** including **Glossary.txt**, **Glossary.doc**, and **Glossy.pdf**. To narrow the processing to a specific type of document, specify **Gloss\*.doc**. This processes all documents that begin with **Gloss** but have the extension **.doc**, such as **Glossary.doc** and **Glossy.doc**. More than one asterisk can be used and all can be placed anywhere within the document name.
- **Question mark ?** Use the question mark as a substitute character within a document name. For example, if you specify **Gloss?.doc**, SilentPrint will process the documents **Glossy.doc** and **Gloss1.doc** but not **Glossary.doc**. More than one question mark can be used and all can be placed anywhere within the document name.

The default file mask is \*.\*.

## Graphic Document Processing

The timeout period for graphic documents (BMP, GIF, JPG/JPEG and TIF/TIFF) has been reduced from 20 minutes to one minute.

Buffer over-runs that occurred when processing certain TIF/TIFF files have been corrected.

---

## HTML Print to File

The problem of only being able to output HTM/HTML documents to a physical printer has been corrected to allow Print to File when selected.

---

## Brackets in Word Document Names

The problem associated with Microsoft Word substituting brackets ( ) with underscores \_ within DOC and RTF document names when they appear in the Windows Print Queue, has been corrected. These documents are no longer placed in the Failed folder and are now processed correctly.

---

## LOG and INI File Locations

In order to comply with Microsoft guidelines that state that no application should create/maintain data files off the **Program Files** folder, **SilentPrint.ini** and **SilentPrint.log** are now stored in **Application Data\SilentPrint** folder within the current user's **Documents and Settings** folder. This change ensures that every user can read/write to these files without any security/privilege issues.
