Updates

SilentPrint 2.10 has the following updates:

- Determine What Supported Document Numeric Extensions are Treated As
- Additional Text Files Parameter Updated
- SilentPrint Exits Quicker

- Job Files and Shortcuts Consider File Mask
- "Lost" DOCs Fix

NOTE: Fixes for SilentPrint 2.06, 2.07, 2.08 and 2.09 are also documented in this TechNote.

Determine What Supported Document Numeric Extensions are Treated As

Documents with a numeric extension (i.e. 001 or 7HB) can now be treated as any document supported by SilentPrint by defining the following parameter in the [TASK] section of the SilentPrint configuration file, SilentPrint.ini:

```
TreatNumericAs=xxx
```

Where xxx is the 3-letter extension of any document supported by SilentPrint.

For example, if documents with a numeric extension needed to be processed by SilentPrint as Adobe PDF documents, include the following:

```
TreatNumericAs=PDF
```

Additional Text Files Parameter Updated

The Additional Text Files parameter has changed so all documents supported by SilentPrint can be treated as text.

For example, if you wanted to treat all HTM documents as text, include the following in the [TASK] or [TEXT FILES OPTION] of the SilentPrint Configuration File, SilentPrint.ini:

```
Additional Text Files=HTM
```

SilentPrint Exits Quicker

SilentPrint no longer waits for a printer to become available (i.e. paper out or offline resolved) before it exits.

Documents Not Moved to Unsupported Folder

Documents that do not match the File Mask configuration are no longer moved by SilentPrint to the Unsupported folder. They instead remain in the Watched folder in case another SilentPrint Task is “watching” the same folder and needs to process them.

Job Files and Shortcuts Consider File Mask

The File Mask configuration is considered when processing Job files and document shortcuts. Before this change the File Mask configuration was ignored.

“Lost” DOCs Fix

On occasion, when printing or converting small DOC files to PDF, certain ones would remain in the ~Pending folder because they were “missed” by SilentPrint when passed to the Windows Print Queue.
